

## **OOC Individual In-Kind Membership**

### **Application Process**

OOC Individual In-Kind Membership is available at no cost to the individual, however the individual is expected to contribute to OOC work efforts. OOC Individual In-Kind Membership includes full OOC membership status for one named individual per organization for 2021.

#### Membership benefits including:

- Discount or no-fee event registration
- Attendance at subcommittee or workgroup meetings
- OOC weekly newsletter distribution
- OOC website access

Individual In-Kind Membership will need majority approval of the OOC Executive Subcommittee. The Executive Subcommittee will vote on Individual In-Kind Memberships during the Board meetings. Applications will need to be submitted to <a href="mailto:angle@theooc.org">angle@theooc.org</a> prior to the Board meeting to be included in that round of voting. All Individual In-Kind Memberships expire at the end of the year and must be renewed through the same process.

- To be eligible for Individual In-Kind Membership starting on January 1, 2021, applications will need to be submitted by November 27, 2020
- To be eligible for Individual In-Kind Membership starting on February 11, 2021, applications will need to be submitted by January 29, 2021
- To be eligible for Individual In-Kind Membership starting on April 8, 2021, applications will need to be submitted by April 2, 2021
- To be eligible for Individual In-Kind Membership starting on June 3, 2021, applications will need to be submitted by May 28, 2021

#### Examples of proposed in-kind participation / services offered could include:

- Serve as a subcommittee / workgroup chair/co-chair
- Actively participate on subcommittees / workgroups
- Assist with the development of OOC documents (comments, output documents, guidance documents, etc.)
- Assist in the planning of OOC workshops, forums and meetings
