The Offshore Operators Committee (OOC) will be hosting a **technology transfer workshop on November 9, 2021**, to disseminate and share information on new developments in waste reduction, recycling and reuse technologies **applicable to offshore energy operations**.

## WORKSHOP & PRESENTATIONS

The technology transfer workshop will be held November 9 in the Houston, TX metro area (exact venue TBD). If you are interested in presenting information on waste reduction, recycling and/or reuse technology:

- Submit your draft presentation to [angie@theocc.org](mailto:angie@theocc.org) by **September 7, 2021**.
- Presentations should be **no more than 20 minutes** in length.
- Presentations **must be technical in content**. Marketing and sales promotions will not be accepted.
- Submit your presentation for consideration **in .pdf format**.
- The OOC workshop committee will review all submitted presentations and select those most appropriate for the workshop objectives.
- **Presenters will be notified of selection results on September 17, 2021**.
- Presentations should **include a description of whether the technology/process is conceptual or commercially-available, and whether the technology/process has received regulatory approval/endorsement**.
- Presentations should **describe specifically what types of waste streams are addressed** by the technology and **how the technology can be applied in offshore energy operations**.
- The workshop audience will be offshore industry HSE, Logistics, Operations & Engineering professionals. Anticipated number of attendees is approximately 50.

- Presentations **must not contain any proprietary information**.
- Presentations **must not contain any information regarding cost of services**.
- Presentations **must not contain any derogatory or negative information about competitors**.
- Acceptance of a presentation for inclusion in the workshop **does not constitute an endorsement by the OOC, or any of our members**, of the company, technology or process being presented.
